Are those the only images ?

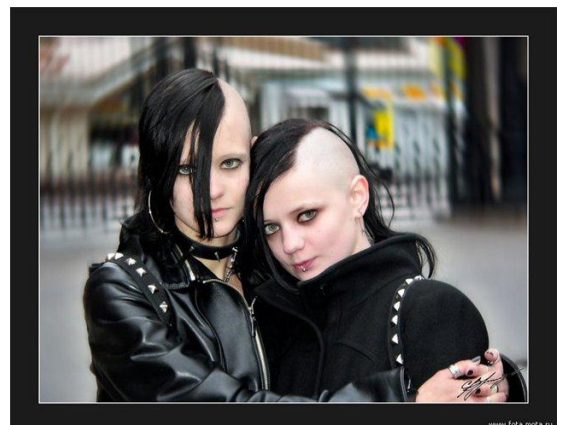
But there are also other stories of where God is.
